## Goals:

In 2023, we hope to...

Pair every person who wants to be in the mentoring program.

Make the Faith and Work lunches productive and successful.

Recruit eight-to-12 new Children's Ministry volunteers for Formation/Children's Ministry events.

Revamp the Children's Worship classroom for Pre-K-Kindergarten to better suit the growing and teaching of the four-to-six-year-olds.

Develop a new nursery curriculum for volunteers to use with our one-, two-, and three-year-olds.

Offer The Talk, a class that supports parents as they talk with their children about the birds and the bees.

Add two bass players, one drummer, and one new sound tech to our volunteer rotation.

Share two more original songs with the congregation and incorporate them into worship.

Youth events would have at least two new kids whose parents do not go to City Church regularly.

Host another Flowers on the Farm this spring for City Church women and friends.

Conduct a mind-body-spirit workshop for City Church for women's formation and health.

Foster ongoing recruitment and development of mentors for women at city Church.

Plan a women's worship/fellowship night.

Train our Ministry Partner Liaisons to be an encouragement and support to each of our Ministry Partners.

Foster deeper connections with our current Ministry Partners.

Bring in \$769,092 in congregational offerings and send \$161,509 back out to our Ministry Partners during the 2022-2023 fiscal year.

Encourage 100% giving participation from all members and regular attendees.

Host three formation events during the "lull" periods of our programming calendar: January, May, and August.

Establish two ongoing events where City Church members are meeting and sharing the love of Christ with non-Christian friends, coworkers, and neighbors.

Nurture increased dependent prayer at City Church evidenced by at least 10 people regularly at Wednesday morning prayer and at least 25 people reading A Praying Church.
